

PLEASE SHOVEL FIRE HYDRANTS

The Middleton Water Utility and Fire Department are asking for assistance in clearing snow away from fire hydrants. As of 2007, Middleton ordinance requires you to remove snow from fire hydrants to a point no higher than four (4) inches below the lowest outlet within 24 hours after the end of a snowfall if you have a hydrant adjacent to your property. It would be helpful if you shoveled a 3 foot area around the hydrant. This will enable the Fire Department to respond much faster in an emergency. Make sure the fire hydrants in your neighborhood are cleared of snow. Inform your neighbor and/or do it yourself. Thank you for your cooperation.
