Kenneth Bradbury received his PhD in Geology from the UW-Madison in 1982, and has been a research hydrogeologist/professor with the Wisconsin Geological and Natural History Survey, University of Wisconsin-Extension, since that time. He serves as Program Leader of water and environmental programs for the Survey.

This talk will discuss groundwater flow in Dane County, with emphasis on the Middleton area. Groundwater is the source for all public water supply in the county and is also essential for maintaining flow in springs, streams, and wetlands.
