WHO: City of Middleton Department of Public Lands

WHAT: Groundbreaking ceremony for Harvey John & Lucille Taylor Memorial Park in honor of Lucille Taylor who will be celebrated for her outstanding generosity in donating her life estate for the development of this park.

WHEN: Monday, May 11, 2015, 5:00pm

WHERE: Meet at City Hall to board the bus to the site

WHY: The City of Middleton is proud to announce the official ground breaking for the newest city park to be known as Harvey John and Lucille Taylor Memorial Community Park located near the entrance of Bishops Bay neighborhood of off county highway Q. Due to no available parking at the site, a bus will depart from city hall to transport guests to the site for the ceremony leaving at 5:00 pm on Monday May 11. Visitors will be shuttled to the location of the newly installed park sign for speeches to signify the occasion at 5:30, followed immediately by a groundbreaking ceremony to kick-off the construction of this community park facility.

A second public celebration will occur in early summer once the playground and parking facilities are installed.
